

Application for SABBATICAL ASSISTANCE

Pastors who qualify may be given up to \$1,000 to match their church's contributions for a sabbatical. The award includes funding to allow the Senior or Lead pastor to be free of church responsibilities for a minimum of two weeks and three Sundays. This award would provide for weekly Pulpit Supply, Pastoral Care for the church on a limited basis, and a week away at an area retreat center. The GTBN will also be available to provide support to the church. Additional elements such as training and renewal events may be included as well.
